BOARD OF HEALTH – meets the 2nd Tuesday of every month at 7:30 PM. This Board is responsible for overseeing the health and welfare of our Community. All septic, water and food handlers permits are issued through the Board of Health. The Board also hears variances regarding distances between wells and septic systems.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE – meets at 7:30 PM on the 4th Monday of every month except July and August. This Committee is charged with reviewing the needs of the business community including bringing new businesses into the Township.

LAND USE BOARD - meets the 3rd and 4th Wednesdays of every month at 7:30 PM. The Land Use Board is a combination of the former Planning and Zoning Boards. This Board hears all development requests as well as Commercial and Residential variances.

OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE – meets the 1st Thursday of every month at 7:30 PM. The Open Space Committee was created this year and charged with the responsibility of studying the preservation of open space via for farmland, conservation and recreational uses as well as historic preservation. The Committee will prepare an Open Space Plan and also identify those parcels, which it believes would be in the best interest of the Township to preserve.

PARK COMMISSIONS – meets the 1st Monday of every month at 7:30 PM. There are also work meetings held at the Township Park on certain Saturdays during the warm weather. The Park Commission oversees the use of the fields and their maintenance, as well as the maintenance of the three homes, which are on the park property.
